In January 2016, Jean-Charles Vollery joined the Executive Committee of SYSTRA Group, before becoming the Group's Chief International & Development Officer and a member of the Executive Board in 2019. From July 2021 until now, Jean-Charles Vollery was Chief Operating Officer.
