

## SYSTRA's transport advice supports Sunderland's Crown Works Studios development

Transport planning and highway engineering advice produced by SYSTRA's Signature Team enabled the successful planning approval for the biggest film and television studios in Europe on the banks of the River Wear, Sunderland.

SYSTRA's Signature Team have been instrumental in supporting the new 38-acre Crown Works Studios in Sunderland, which will unlock significant economic investment and regeneration for the immediate and wider area.

Commissioned by the developer <u>FullwellCain</u>, <u>SYSTRA</u> experts <u>provided</u> transport planning advice and the technical reports to accompany the planning application, and also prepared the preliminary design of roadworks and road infrastructure. Sunderland City Council has now approved the £450m Crown Works Studios, which is expected to generate £336m in GVA per year for the UK's economy. The site is located at the former Pallion shipyard on the south side of the River Wear and is set to become the biggest film studios in Europe.

The Crown Works Studios development will provide a new home for Britain's flourishing creative sector as the state-of-the-art facilities will be capable of attracting major international TV and film productions. The studios will create more than 8,000 new jobs in the region and around 21,000 jobs across the UK's creative sector.
